Adventure Camp

June 19, 20, 21 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 3:00 *At the Hurstville Interpretive Center* Cost: \$35
For youth entering 5th–8th grade next fall. Learn outdoor recreation skills such as paddling, archery and more!

Ranger Camp

July 10, 11, 12 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 2:00 *At the Hurstville Interpretive Center* Cost: \$35
For youth entering 2nd–4th grade next fall. Have fun outdoors while learning about Iowa’s natural resources!

Explorer Camp

July 17, 18, 19 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 2:00 *At the Hurstville Interpretive Center* Cost: \$35
For youth entering Kdg-1st grade next fall. Have fun while learning about nature and wildlife!

Yellow River Backpacking Trip

August 8, 9, 10 *At Yellow River State Forest in NE Iowa* Cost: \$50
For youth ages 11-17. Join naturalists and youth from Clinton, Dubuque and Jackson Counties on a 3-day, 2-night backpacking trip to Yellow River. We’ll hike, camp, cook outdoors and learn other outdoor skills. Youth will be required to attend a pre-trip meeting (date TBD) to prepare for the trip. Food, gear and transportation are included in cost.

- ◆ Registration and payment is due by Friday before camp starts. No late registrations will be taken.
- ◆ Max number is 20 kids per day camp. Max is 12 for backpacking trip. First come, first served.
- ◆ We provide lunch, snacks, transportation (backpacking trip and Adventure Camp) and equipment for camps.
- ◆ The Maquoketa Art Experience will provide 1 hour of art instruction each day during the Explorer and Ranger camps.
- ◆ Camp will be cancelled in the event of severe weather, a decision will be made 45 minutes prior to the start of camp.
- ◆ Youth should bring a water bottle, hat, sunscreen, bug spray and a complete change of clothes, shoes and socks in a backpack (kids love to get in the water!). Leave all electronics at home.
- ◆ Youth should wear clothing and shoes appropriate for the weather and outdoors. We will be outside the majority of the time. No flip flops or other shoes/sandals that would fall off easily.
