Did you know that the Black Hawk County Conservation Board (BHCCB) manages 37 parks and wildlife areas and over 8000 acres? Most of these areas are open to hiking, canoeing, fishing and hunting. To find these areas is as easy as a few key strokes on your computer. First, go to the BHCCB website at www.blackhawkcountyparks.com. This website lists all of the county parks, facilities, programs and provides an aerial map and directions on a printable PDF. Second, when you get to the website, click on the pull-down tab labeled Parks. These areas are organized in alphabetical order so look for the area you would like. This page will give you a brief overview of the area. At the bottom of this page is an aerial map on a printable PDF file. This map shows the ground cover and how to access the parking area(s) from the nearest roads.
