In our efforts to keep summer camp as safe as we possibly can, we want to inform you of the procedures we will be following during the three-day camp. - If a staff person has been exposed, camp will be cancelled.

- Staff with a 100.4 temperature will be sent home and camp will be cancelled.
- Campers will not be required to wear face masks or gloves. They can if they choose.
- Campers will wash hands with soap and water upon arrival and before and after eating and any
 other time deemed necessary.
- Snacks will all be prepackaged.
- Please educate your child on keeping their physical distance from other campers they are not associated with. We cannot guarantee children will social distance 100% of the time.
