THE EVENT

Designed to give inexperienced deer hunters a hands-on introduction to the sport of deer hunting, the Mentored Deer Hunt includes the opportunity to harvest a deer within Lake Ahquabi State Park with the assistance of a mentor.

A multitude of topics are covered to make participants feel comfortable and safe hunting deer in lowa. Topics covered include deer biology/management, deer hunting equiptment/methods, laws, safety, field dressing and game processing. Gun range time is included.

FACILITY

The Mentored Deer Hunt is headquartered at Warren County Conservation Board's Annett Nature Center and neighboring Lake Ahquabi State Park south of Indianola. The diverse habitats of the area make it an ideal location for this opportunity.

AGENDA

The program starts at 6:15 pm on Thursday, November 1st, with educational programs that evening, Friday evening and Saturday morning. On Saturday mid-morning we will start hunting in the park and continue hunting on Sunday.

MENTORS

A mentor can be a relative, friend of the hunter or assigned from our group of volunteers. Those interested in mentoring should fill out the registration contact information to volunteer. This is a great opportunity to share your experience with a novice hunter. A mentor must be 18 years of age or older and must have a valid lowa hunting license and habitat fee.

TO REGISTER

Hunters must have successfully completed a certified hunter safety course. Fill out and return the form on the back of this brochure. The registration fee is \$40 per hunter, which covers one resident deer tag for the park hunt, all meals, instructors, and materials for the hunter. If the hunter is 16 years of age or older they will also be required to have an lowa hunting license and habitat fee, which will be available for purchase on Friday night. The mentor participates at no charge. Registration deadlines:
