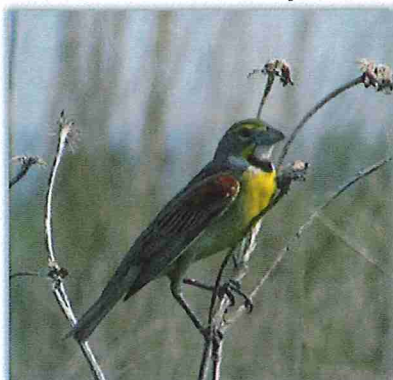
## Time and Location
