## **Cross Country Ski Rental**

## **Rules:**

A minimum of 4 inches of snow must be on the ground to permit skiing with Hardin County Conservation, cross country ski equipment. It is strongly advised to call the nature center at 641-648-9878 before coming to the nature center to ensure a staff member will be available. Do not wear the skis on pavement, gravel, or in the building. All persons renting skis must sign the Terms of Rental Agreement below to rent skis.

## **Terms of Rental Agreement:**

You are renting cross country skis and associated equipment from Hardin County Conservation, and by signing this document you agree to the following terms. Skis and associated equipment shall be inspected for wear and defect when issued to renter. Skis and associated equipment will be returned in the same condition in which they were issued, and free of snow, dirt, defect, and boot laces must be tied together.

The duration and cost of the rental agreement is as follows:

FREE – if staying at Calkin's Nature Area (8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday – Friday) \$8 for one day (8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) \$16 for entire weekend (8:00 a.m. Friday – 3:30 p.m. Monday)

Rental payment must be made in full at the time of signing the rental agreement. Skis must be returned clean and free of snow and ice. If skis are returned damaged, a replacement fee will be assessed.

Hardin County Conservation does not assume any liability for injury or death associated with the use of our cross country skiing equipment, regardless if potential injury would happen on Hardin County Property or any other property. Hardin County Conservation does not assume any liability for injury or death at any of the Hardin County Parks; whether it is related to cross country skiing or any other recreational activities. All of the above terms apply to anyone using the rented equipment, not only the person who has signed this form. ## Fitting Skis, Poles, & Boots:

Boots- Our ski boots are European Sizes. Sizes are written on the back of the boot. Use the size conversion chart to make sure you get the correct size.

Poles – Ski Poles should go from the floor up to the person's arm pit.

Skis – Raise your arms into the air, the tip of the ski should extend to the person's finger tips or close to them.
