



Purpose of Area:

- Special use permit must be obtained from the county conservation office prior to hunting.
- Permit must be displayed so that it's visible from outside the vehicle
- Permit is not transferable
- Maximum of 4 persons.

Minimum of 2 persons (1 adult for each youth). Youth must be 15 years and under.

Adult must be 21 ---- 11 11.

- The two permit times are from 1 hour before opening time through 12 (noon) and from noon to 1 hour after closing time.
- Park your vehicle in designated areas only.
- Honor all boundaries and refuge restrictions.
- Boats or canoes without motors are allowed.

- Leave remains of field cleaned game at least 50 yards away from parking and roads.
- Permit and survey card must be returned to Hamilton County Conservation office before another permit will be issued.
- 11. The Conservation Department reserves the right to issue or deny approval of permit.
- 12. Use non-toxic shot only.
- 13. All State of Iowa Game Laws apply.
- Youth under age 16 do not have to have a hunting license.
- The youth does not have to have taken Hunter Safety.
- One limit of game can be taken if the youth is not licensed to hunt.
- Two limits of game can be taken if the youth is licensed to hunt. (However, HCCB encourages only one limit to be taken to help provide the greatest abundance of game for the youth that hunt after you)
