## VISION: NEXT STEPS

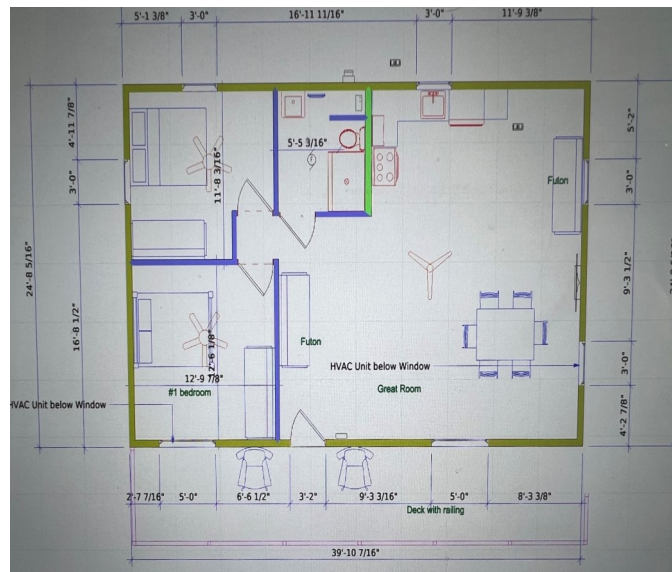

Cabin Floor Plan

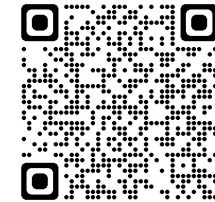
