
Black Hawk Wildlife Area

180 ACRES



This 180-acre public hunting area along the South Fork of the Maquoketa River was purchased in 4 different parcels, including a former Boy Scout Camp. This area contains a system of trails for hiking and is also open for equestrian use June through August. Trail system totals 2 miles but be aware high water levels may affect some sections. Wildlife food plots attract multiple species. Trails also provide opportunity for cross country skiing during winter months.

This area can be accessed by traveling 3 miles west of Maquoketa on highway 64 and 2 miles north on County Road 138th Avenue.
